<b>ACCEPTANCE</b>	In order to be evaluated by the academic coordinator, students must send by post (according to the application deadline), before their arrival: - the original application form and - the original learning agreement.	
<b>REGISTRATION</b>	Erasmus students are administratively registered by the International Office when they submit the original registration documents (identity card or passport, European Health Insurance Card, 3 photos).	
<b>SYSTEM OF STUDY COURSES</b>	The basic unit of a study programme is a course. A typical course consists of series of lectures and an assignment. An assignment can be either a written exam or a written assignment.	
<b>EXAM PERIOD</b>	<b>Autumn Semester</b> 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of January – 1 <sup>st</sup> week of February (2 weeks)	<b>Spring Semester</b> 2 <sup>rd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> week of June (2 weeks)
<b>GRADE SYSTEM</b>	Hellenic grading system is based on a 1 to 10 scale: Less than 5 – FAIL	
<b>CREDIT SYSTEM</b>	TEI of Athens has completely adopted the ECTS credit system. The estimated workload for full time student in one academic year is 60 ECTS credits, meaning 30 ECTS credits per semester and 20 ECTS credits for a third-month period.	
<b>STUDENT FEES</b>	TEI of Athens does not charge Erasmus students with tuition fees.	
<b>LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS</b>	English: B.2 Main language of instruction at TEI of Athens is Greek but there are many courses also available in English.	
<b>ACCOMMODATION</b>	The International Office of TEI of Athens does not find accommodation for students. The students themselves should look after this, in accordance with their personal preferences. <b>SAFETY AND HEALTH</b>	In case of illness abroad, it is highly recommended to all students from E.U. to obtain the Health Insurance European Card. Concerning students from Turkey, it is necessary to have a private health insurance.	
<b>IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS</b>	Students from E.U. must be equipped with an identity card or passport. Students from Turkey must have a student visa.
